No Square Theatre has established an **IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENT** in line with accepted public health policies.

Performers in rehearsals have a lot of physical contact-- holding hands, passing props, singing in one another's faces, etc. This pretty much guarantees that they'll be sharing bugs, both the microscopic variety and even the creepy-crawly variety. Please understand that we make every effort to protect the health of our cast and creative staff, and this immunization policy, along with hand washing, staying home when sick, not sharing costumes, etc., are all a part of that.

For children with medical exemptions, the physician's written statement should be submitted. There are no other exceptions.

Polio	4 doses at any age, but 3 doses meet requirement for ages 4–6 years if at least one was given on or after the 4 th birthday ¹ ; 3 doses meet requirement for ages 7–17 years if at least one was given on or after the 2 nd birthday. ¹

	<i>Age 7-17 years and not entering or advancing into 7th grade:</i> 1 dose on or after 1 st birthday. ¹	
Hepatitis B ³	Age 4-6 years (kindergarten and above): 3 doses.	
Varicella	1 dose ^{4,6}	
Tdap Booster (Tetanus, reduced diphtheria, and pertussis)	7th grade : 1 dose on or after 7 th birthday. ^{5, 7}	

¹ Receipt of a dose up to (and including) 4 days before the birthday will satisfy the school entry immunization requirement.

If you have not been immunized as noted above, please do not audition. You will not be cast. Before rehearsals start, all cast members must sign below to confirm they are in compliance with this policy. You may also be asked to provide Immunization Records.

² Two doses of measles-containing vaccine required. One dose of mumps and rubella-containing vaccine required; mumps vaccine is not required for children 7 years of age and older.

⁵ Tdap, DTaP, or DTP given on or after 7th birthday will meet the requirement. Td does not meet the requirement.

⁶ 2 dose varicella requirement for ages 13-17 years applies to transfer students who were not admitted to a California school before July 1, 2001.
